Eleanor Blakeney was Born in Rocky Mt. North Carolina on November 2, 1925, the youngest child, to the Late Edward and Maggie Morgan. The family moved to Philadelphia, PA. where Eleanor was

educated within the Philadelphia School system. She attended Fitz Simon and Gratz High schools.

Eleanor was employed with the Philadelphia Board of Education and was there until her retirement. She loved her work there and established many friendships. She married the Late Nathaniel James Mask in August 1947, and they were blessed with five children. Nathaniel passed away in 1980. Eleanor married the Late Robert Blakeney in May 1990. In 2005, she moved to Chesterfield, VA. to be closer to her family.

One Bible teaching that encouraged her was the hope of the resurrection, which became even more important when her sister died. She felt she could make better progress toward her spiritual goals if she moved from Philadelphia to Richmond where she continued in her study of the Bible.
