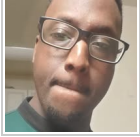

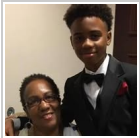

Doolah: Who is that Talking?

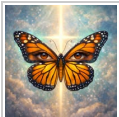
Car: I dont understand

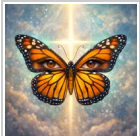
