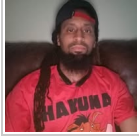

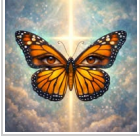
“ *Grandma Nancy, one of my favorite people, the softest hands, most contagious laugh, and my favorite cook. I'll always hold you in my heart.*
