In June of 1970, the family relocated to North Carolina. At that time the family attended the Wilson Congregation.

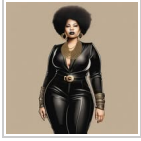
In 1974, Nate married Gwendolyn James of Wilson, NC, and from this union, one son was born.
